#### Comprehension Skill and Strategy

<u>Author's Purpose</u>- use text details to figure out the author's reasons for writing

<u>Text Organization</u>- the way a text is organized (compare and contrast, time/sequential order, cause and effect, problem and solution)

**Decoding** breaking words into syllables review (\*indicates new strategy)

1. Open syllable ends with the long vowel sound ex. pre - serve, de-cline,

2. Closed syllable, closes in the vowel with a consonant so short vowel sound ex. rec-og-nize,

3. When there is a VCCV split the two consonants ex. com-plain, con-tain, com-pa-ny

\*4. Vowel + r in multisyllable words ex. card-board, cer-tain

5. Blends stay together in a syllable to form sound ex. an-swer, east-ern

**Synonyms**-words that have similar meanings. When choosing synonyms, make sure the word makes sense based on the sentence it is being used in.
