Sequence of Events - Use details to tell how events happened and the order in which they happened. Use signal words such as *then, again, now, and when* to help.

Summarize-restate the most important ideas in your own words

Suffix- When adding the suffix *-ation* and *-ition* to words, the word changes from a verb to a noun.

	Meaning	Example
-ion	process, action, result	suggestion (idea to consider)
-ation	action, process	imagination (act of imagining)
-ition	result, action	exhibition (public display)

Decoding - words with the same *g* sound (mileage and danger) and suffix *-age*.(carriage: carry and *-age*)
