## Comprehension Skill and Strategy

Compare and Contrast- explain how things are alike and different based on text evidence.

Fact and Opinion- a fact is something that can be proven, an opinion is based on how someone feels about something (can differ from person to person or instance)

Context Clues - use text evidence to figure out what words mean

**Decoding** - breaking VCCCV words into syllables

VCCCV words are always made with two blended consonants. The word then will be split so that the blended consonants stay together. Examples of blended consonants include *ck, cl, bl, gh, pl, st, pr, th, rt, nd, tr*

ex-plo-sion, ad-dress, con-trol
