## Comprehension Skill and Strategy

Conclusions and Generalizations- figure out unstated or broad ideas

Question-ask questions before, during, and after reading to better understand the story

**Decoding** breaking words into syllables review

1. Recognize beginning syllables (a, be, de, pre, com, con)

ex. com-plain, con-tain, com-pa-ny, de-lay

**Antonyms**-words that have opposite meanings
